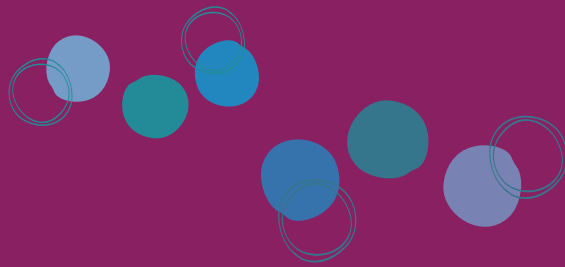


# Raise and Give
